

It's tea time!

People often have scones with their tea. Scones are small cakes.
Here is the recipe for scones with clotted cream¹. Use a dictionary if you need help.

Ingredients

- 400g flour
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 100g butter, cut into cubes
- 4 tbsp sugar
- 200ml milk
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- squeeze of lemon juice
- 1 egg, beaten
- jam
- clotted cream



1. Mix the flour, salt and baking powder.
2. Add the butter and then stir in the sugar.
3. Heat the milk until it's warm. Add the vanilla extract and the lemon juice.
4. Mix everything together and knead it thoroughly.
5. Divide the dough into eight parts. These are the scones.
6. Cover the scones with the beaten egg.
7. Bake for 10 minutes.
